PURPOSE:

The purpose of the Summer Food and Enrichment Program (SFEP) is to provide extended-year education to prevent summer learning loss. Our academic enrichment program provides instruction on language arts, mathematics, nutrition, and the fine arts. The program is designed to teach social skills and character development. Learning opportunities occur both onsite and in the community at various venues. The program also provides two healthy meals and a snack daily, as well as a power-pack weekend meals to all program participants.

WHAT IS PROVIDED:

Healthy meals, activities and a snack.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE:

- ***For breakfast and lunch***— participants ages of 1—18 years old.
- ***For the entire day (includes the meals, activities, and snacks)***— participants ages of 5—12 years old.

COST:

- ***For the entire day***— \$75/child/week (\$375 due at time of orientation)
- ***For breakfast and lunch only***— FREE
- ***For outings*** — varies, some are FREE
